Bulletin's Expands Ground Around Aldoro's Niobe Project Mt Farmer Project

Bulletin Resources Limited ("Bulletin", "BNR") is pleased to announce that two new tenement applications have been added to the Mt Farmer Project.




Figure 1: Bulletin's Mt Farmer Project and Aldoro's Niobe Rubidium-Lithium Project location

These new tenement applications almost double the area of the Mt Farmer Project from 59km^2 to 106km^2 . The project completely surrounds Aldoro's 2km^2 P59/2137 which hosts the Niobe Rubidium-Lithium Project and a resource of $4.6 \text{Mt} \ @ 0.17\% \ \text{Rb}_2\text{O}$ and $0.07\% \ \text{Li}_2\text{O}$ (Figure 1) (refer ARN ASX announcement dated 12 October 2022).

Bulletin's tenement applications have over 5km strike of the potential greenstone host to the Rubidium bearing pegmatite unit. The applications also cover potential northeast extensions to the Dalgaranga gold mine.

The applications are progressing through the DMIRS tenement grant process and on-ground works will commence upon grant of the Exploration Licences.
