Executive Summary

First mining royalty of \$17k was received during the Quarter.

Connected IO continues remained focused on growing the Australasian business through leveraging the Company's intellectual property in Internet of Things (IOT) devices, IOT Cloud Management Platform and associated software development services. The Company is focussed on expanding its capability and capacity in this market through potential complementary acquisition opportunities.

While the Company remains focused on actively pursuing acquisition opportunities, it welcomes the opportunity to benefit from future cash royalty payments should further mining activities be conducted on any of the tenements triggering the entitlement or to consider the potential sale of the royalty.

Mining Royalty

The Company has received its first royalty payment from Focus Minerals Ltd (ASX:FML) ("Focus Minerals"), the owner of the Coolgardie Project located in the Coolgardie township in the Western Australian Eastern Goldfields.

Although minimal in value, the first royalty payment signals the commencement of sales by Focus Minerals from the Coolgardie Project to third parties and the potential for future revenue to be generated by the Company pursuant to the royalty.

Strategic Growth Plan

Connected IO has continued to evaluate potential acquisition opportunities, with several progressing through negotiations to formal due diligence.

The underlying objective of the Company continued to grow the business via organic growth in Southeast Asia and Australasian region and acquisition of complementary business(s) to

accelerate scale in core IOT business and expand competencies to participate in high-growth adjacent markets to deliver superior shareholder value in the medium to longer term.

Expiry of Yojee Agreement

The the Memorandum of Understanding (“**MOU**”) with the client, Yojee Limited (“**Yojee**”) (as announced on 14 April 2022) expired in December 2022.

Financial and Corporate

At the end of the quarter the Company held cash of approximately \$2.0 million with debt of approximately \$220,000.

Operating cash outflows were lower than last quarter due to the ceasing of the Yojee contract. Staff costs of \$55,000 and administration and corporate costs of \$46,000 were comparable to last quarter.

Related party payments reported in Item 6.1 of the Appendix 4C of \$54,000 represent directors fees and corporate management fees paid during the quarter.

Suspension from Quotation

ASX has determined that CIO’s operations are not adequate to warrant the continued quotation of its securities and therefore is in breach of Listing Rule 12.1. The suspension will continue until Connected IO is able to demonstrate compliance with Listing Rule 12.1 of the Listing Rules.
