

Highlights 2023



Listed on ASX –July 2022

- Raised \$5m to explore and appraise Serowe CBM Project.
- Develop CBM together with early-stage research and development including solar projects.
- Botala is operator and owns 70% of the Serowe CBM; PH2 retains 30% and is free-carried until completion of farm-in which is anticipated to be completed by 30 June 2023.



Resource Upgrade

- Independently gross certified resource^{1,2} increased to 317bcf (2C) & 8,008 bcf (3C).
- Based on the 5 wells drilled to date (not including Serowe-6 & Serowe-7).

Flow-testing Underway.


- Serowe-3 flow-testing commissioned and testing underway visible gas presence.


