

## ASX ANNOUNCEMENT

NRW Holdings Limited (ASX:NWH) is pleased to advise that its wholly owned subsidiary Golding Contractors Pty Ltd (Golding) has executed a Contract with the Toowoomba Regional Council (TRC) for works under the 2022 Flood Recovery Project – South Package, which includes the permanent reconstruction of existing Council assets that were damaged in the February 2022 flood event. The project is jointly funded by the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DFRA).

Works will be undertaken on more than 2500 individual sites (covering 6,500 km<sup>2</sup>) and include sealed and unsealed pavement reconstruction, culvert replacements, general earthworks, formation and shoulder grading of rural roads, rock protection and drainage desilting together with landslip remediation works.

The contract is valued at circa \$113 million and is structured on cost reimbursable basis.

Mobilisation is expected to commence in August 2023 with a completion date of October 2024.

Golding CEO Geoff Caton commenting on the Contract award said, “We are excited to be given the opportunity to deliver this project for Toowoomba Regional Council, using our extensive experience in delivering flood recovery works in regional and remote areas”
