- as at 26 September 2023, the 10,500,000 unlisted options on issue are held by 7 holders. Each option has an exercise price of \$0.30 and an expiry date of 18 March 2025.
- there is no current on-market buy-back applicable to the Company.
- the Company has used the cash and assets in a form readily convertible to cash that it had available to it at
 the time of admission to the ASX towards exploration activities on its South Australian projects where
 access has been unrestricted and on the newly acquired NSW tenements, in addition to meeting ongoing
 working capital and corporate expenditures.
