

Drilling Results Update Highway Project in South Australia ASX Release – 24th November 2023

Taiton Resources Limited ("T88", "Taiton" or "the company") is pleased to provide an update on its activities at the Highway Project (Figure 1) in the Gawler Craton of South Australia. Following the approval from the Department of Mines and Energy in South Australia for our second drilling program at Merino Prospect, Taiton wishes to inform you that the second drilling program has been completed.



Figure 1: Location of Taiton South Australian projects. The pink dot represents the location of the Merino prospect and the current location of the drilling program. Green mines are IOCG deposits.



The 2nd drilling program consisted of 1,896m drilled across sixteen RC holes (Table 1). A total of 1,001 samples have been collected and submitted to the lab in Adelaide for assay.
