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
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# The Premier Perth Basin Exposure

### **2024 Investment Highlights**


- 1. 100% operated position with substantial Reserves & Resources
  - Less than 50% of existing 2P Reserves contracted
  - >3,000 km<sup>2</sup> of acreage and more than 25 prospects and leads
  - Three substantial prospective targets to be drilled in 2024
- 2. Perth Basin's largest domestic gas producer generating low cost cashflows
  - Q4 CY23 generated gross \$14.4m in cashflow
  - Production costs of only \$0.5 GJ
  - Walyering reached above nameplate production record on the 6<sup>th</sup> of Feb at 34 TJ & 275 bbls of condensate
  - Average sales for February of 27 TJ/d
- 3. Govt supported gas acceleration strategy
  - Targeting up to four sources of gas online by 2026<sup>1</sup>
  - Well capitalised with ~\$114m of cash and undrawn debt with ongoing cash generation and only \$19m of drawn debt as at Q4/23.
  - Government domgas policy review and possible stimulus via potential LNG policy changes
- 4. Catalyst rich
  - Walyering: Appraisal drilling in Q2, with potential production increase
  - South Erregulla: Flow testing at SE2 and resource review
  - West Erregulla: 2 x nearfield exploration wells in Q2/Q3 with development decision targeting 2H/24
  - Ocean Hill: 3D seismic commencing, with contingent appraisal Q4

### Potential WA Gas Supply & Demand Forecast GSOO 2023 (TJ/d)




#### Near term gas supply looks delicate, WA Govt reviewing policy

- AEMO GSOO 2023 released showing in and out of supply deficit '23-29, even with Alcoa closures.
- WA spot gas prices of \$9.47/GJ during the quarter.
- DMIRS announced that 2023 was the lowest year for gas exploration in the State of WA for the last 25 years.




# Power market looking for sustainable solutions


- Gas price being driven by electricity market (Q4/23 WA averaged \$98 MWh equivalent to ~\$9.8 GJ).
- Electricity demand record set in Nov '23 (~4,100 MW, 800 MW higher than previous). Gas made up 56% of electricity at 6pm on that date.
- WA Govt to cease subsidising coal by 2026 and continue to retire coal fired power stations by 2029.



# South Erregulla appraisal ongoing



- Appraisal drilling has likely shown 3-separate fault compartments, with the middle compartment being down-thrown.
- SE3 is the lowest intersection of the Kingia Sandstone within the field, encountered water and minor gas when on test.
- SE2 is updip of SE3 & SE1 (SE1 flowed 80mmscfd on test), with flow testing to commence this week.
- Post flow testing campaign, Strike will review Reserves and Resources which will inform path to development.



# Other Project 2024 key catalysts



- Ramp up in daily production.
- Walyering-7: April (immediate tie in on success).
- RISC Reserves & Resources review.
- Potential de-bottlenecking and increase in production capacity.
- Further gas marketing and market development activities.



- Ministerial decision on environmental approval expected 1H/24.
- Erregulla Deep-1: May.
- FID on 87 TJ/d development with Warrego Energy: Targeting 2H/24.
- Southwest Erregulla-1: 2H/24.



- 3D seismic acquisition has commenced.
- Ocean Hill-2: appraisal drilling in Q4/24 (contingent on seismic).
