## UPDATE ON MOBILISATION FOR CAMEL CREEK DRILLING

**Inca Minerals Ltd** (ASX: ICG, “*Inca*” or “*the Company*”) wishes to update the market on its planned Camel Creek drilling at the Jean Elson prospect in central Northern Territory. The Company previously advised that it planned to mobilise to site and commence the inaugural drilling campaign at Jean Elson in late April. However, as flagged in the recently released Quarterly report, there has been a Category 3 cyclone that came through the area a number of weeks ago and many roads in the area have been closed to traffic since then.

Inca has been daily monitoring the current status of road closures and is in constant contact with the drillers who are ready to mobilise to site as soon as conditions allow. Many of the roads have recently opened but are subject to extreme caution. However, the critical road link between Boulia and Tobermorey, just over the NT border, on what is essentially the Plenty Highway was still closed to all traffic, until today. This road is the only way Inca and the drilling Company can travel having to come from the Mt Isa base.

Now that the road has just been opened and can only be accessed with extreme caution, Inca personnel will immediately mobilise to site and assess whether further work is required on the off-road access tracks to allow the heavy drill rig to access the site. Once Inca personnel assesses and confirms that the roads are accessible, the drillers will mobilise to site for drilling. This will be a much-anticipated drilling program which will not be a long program and should be completed in approximately 10 days.

Whilst the delays in being able to access the Camel Creek site has been extremely frustrating there is no control over the weather, and its impacts on the ability to travel, especially at this time of the year in Northern Australia when the monsoon season can still be active. The drilling site is extremely remote and all due caution had to be exercised in undertaking the proposed drilling program.
