Update: Appointment of Receivers and Managers Entyr Ltd (ASX: ETR)

As previously announced, Travis Anderson and Richard Hughes were appointed Voluntary Administrators (the “Administrators”) of Entyr Ltd (Administrators Appointed), Pearl Global Management Pty Ltd (Administrators Appointed), Keshi Technologies Pty Ltd (Administrators Appointed, Australian Tyre Processors Pty Ltd (Administrators Appointed) and Rubber Reclamation Industries Pty Ltd (Administrators Appointed) (together “Entyr” or “the Group”) on 26 March 2024.

On 17 April 2024, Richard Tucker, Anthony Miskiewicz and David Johnstone of Korda Mentha were appointed Receivers and Managers of Entyr Limited (Administrators Appointed) (Receivers and Managers Appointed) specifically over Entyr Limited’s right, title and interest in the following:

- a. Any shares held by Entyr Limited
- b. Any debts owed to Entyr Limited by any related entity (as that term is defined in the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth))
- c. The Proceeding¹ and any Claims² of Entyr Limited which are the subject of the Proceeding
- d. The Books³ of Entyr Limited

The Administrators are currently scheduled to provide a report to creditors by 3 May 2024, with the second meeting of creditors to be held by 13 May 2023.
