## INCA COMPLETES INITIAL JEAN ELSON DRILLING PROGRAM

## Highlights

- Planned drilling at Jean Elson has been completed with 7 drillholes for 462m at the Ningaloo and Sunset Boulevarde Prospects.
- Logging of drill chips is underway, and samples have been submitted to ALS laboratory for analysis.
- Further work including modelling of geophysical data is needed to determine next steps.

Further to its ASX announcement of 22 May 2024, Inca Minerals Limited (**ASX: ICG; Inca or the Company**) provides an update on the progress of the maiden drill program at Camel Creek and Sunset Boulevarde Prospects, Jean Elson Project in the Northern Territory.

Inca Minerals advises that it has now completed its initial drilling campaign at the Camel Creek area at the Jean Elson Project in the Northern Territory. A total of 7 holes were drilled for 462 m and these tested both known outcropping mineralised veins and shallow geophysical (gravity and magnetics) targets.

Following the completion of drilling all holes were rehabilitated as shown by the example of drillhole, JE240007 (Figure 1). Samples have been sent for priority assay and once assay results have been received the market will be informed of the results.
