Data Incident

3 June 2024: Schrole Group Ltd (ASX: SCL) ("**Schrole**" or the "**Company**"), provider of accredited training and global Human Resources (HR) Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) provides the following update regarding a data breach incident.

Schrole has experienced an incident which it understands has resulted in a third party obtaining unauthorised access to personal information of certain candidates who had registered on the Schrole platform.

The incident has had no impact on the Company's ongoing operations. Schrole's platform was not locked down or otherwise impacted by the incident and no impact on schools using Schrole's platform has been identified.

On detecting the incident, Schrole took immediate action to remove the unauthorised access and deploy measures to mitigate the risk of recurrence of the incident. An investigation was launched and Schrole and its external experts continue to work to determine the extent of the incident and the impact to personal information. At this stage of the investigation, the Company cannot confirm the likely number of candidates affected however understands that the third party had access to a subset of Schrole's data involving the personal information of candidates.

The Company will identify, inform and support individuals whose personal information may have been affected in line with its obligations.

The Company has engaged with its cyber insurers and notified the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner and the Information Commissioner's Office (UK).

We will continue to keep our candidates, shareholders and key stakeholders updated as we respond to this event and our investigation continues and further facts are established.
