

Cleansing Notice Under Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)

Provaris Energy Ltd (ASX: PV1) (Provaris, or the Company) issues this notice pursuant to section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (**Corporations Act**).

The Company has issued 6,887,500 fully paid ordinary shares in the Company (**New Shares**) to the underwriters of the Company's Share Purchase Plan, the completion of which was announced to the ASX on 11 July 2024.

The Company issued the New Shares without disclosure under section 708A(5) of the Corporations Act.

In accordance with section 708A(6) of the Corporations Act, the Company provides notice to the ASX that:

1. it has issued the New Shares without disclosure under Part 6D.2 of the Corporations Act;
2. as at the date of this notice, the Company has complied with:
 - a. the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Corporations Act as they apply to the Company; and
 - b. section 674 of the Corporations Act; and
3. as at the date of this notice, there is no "excluded information" of the type referred to in section 708A(7) and 708A(8) of the Corporations Act that investors and their professional advisors would reasonably have expected to find in a disclosure document.
