## Earthworks Underway for Drilling at Christmas Creek

Maiden 8,000m drill program due to commence in the coming weeks

### Highlights

Field work continuing at the flagship Christmas Creek Gold & REE Project:

- Earthworks have commenced, paving the way for upcoming drilling.
- Soil sampling is ongoing, targeting both gold and REE mineralisation.
- Heritage survey for untested high-priority gold drill target completed.
- Drill rig secured and scheduled to start drilling in the coming weeks.

Multiple drill targets defined:

- Four high-priority gold prospects – Coogan, Martin, Zahn and Willis.
- One REE/Niobium target along strike from the Cummins Range REE Deposit.
