## **Update on Proposed Divestment of Northern Territory Projects**

Eclipse Metals Ltd (ASX: **EPM**) (**Eclipse Metals** or the **Company**) advises that despite multiple efforts to consummate the proposed transaction with Oz Yellow Uranium Limited (ACN 651 734 600) (**Oz Yellow**) for the sale of its interests in certain Northern Territory tenements, including its Ngalia Basin Uranium Prospects and the Liverpool Uranium Project (**NT Projects**), it has decided not to continue to pursue the transaction. As a result, the Company has formally terminated the binding heads of agreement originally entered into with Oz Yellow and announced to the ASX on 29 November 2021.

The Company is continuing to explore alternative avenues to maximise value for its shareholders in respect of the NT Projects. In this regard, the Company is in active discussions with various potential third-party purchasers and will provide an update to shareholders in accordance with its continuous disclosure obligations in the event a binding transaction is entered into. However, shareholders should note that there is no guarantee that a definitive transaction will be agreed with a preferred purchaser.
