Request for voluntary suspension – ASX Listing Rule 17.2

We refer to the trading halt granted to Freedom Care Group Holdings Limited (FCG) on 12 November 2024.

Pursuant to Listing Rule 17.2, FCG requests the voluntary suspension of trading in its securities from the commencement of trading on Thursday 14 November 2024. FCG provides the following information regarding this request:

- the voluntary suspension is requested as FCG is still in discussions with the National Disability
 Insurance Agency regarding the payment suspension referred to in FCG's ASX announcement dated
 6 November 2024 and is not yet in a position to make an announcement regarding such
 discussions;
- it is requested that the voluntary suspension be put in place until the Company is in a position to make the announcement which, at this stage, is expected to be no later than the commencement of normal trading on 16 December 2024; and
- FCG is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension request should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
