VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION REQUEST

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Sprintex Limited (ACN 106 337 599) (ASX: SIX) (**Company** or **SIX**) requests a voluntary suspension of its securities from ASX, prior to commencement of trading on Friday, 15 November 2024.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information regarding this request:

- 1. a voluntary suspension is being requested to allow the Company to make an application to the Supreme Court of Western Australia seeking orders in relation to:
 - (a) the Company's failure to lodge cleansing notices under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporation Act 2001 (Cth) (Corporations Act) in relation to issues of Shares that occurred between 8 September 2023 and 22 December 2023; and
 - (b) cleansing notices issued by the Company between 5 February 2024 and 19 July 2024 incorrectly stating that the Company was in compliance with Chapter 2M of the Corporations Act due to a failure by the Company to lodge its annual report for the financial year ended 30 June 2023 within the time required under Chapter 2M of the Corporations Act;
- 2. the Company requests the voluntary suspension continue until the earlier of the commencement of trading on Tuesday, 19 November 2024 and the Company releasing an announcement in relation to the outcome of the Court application, which is currently listed to be heard on Monday, 18 November 2024. The Company is in the process of finalising the documents required for the Court application;
- 3. the Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted; and
- 4. the Company is not aware of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
