






EXTENSION GROWING THE HIGH-GRADE BIG RED SYSTEM



Thick, shallow, high-grade lithium deposit

- Discovered multiple near-surface, thick, high-grade, shallow-dipping LCT pegmatites
- Stacked, mineralised system progressively defined across Big Red, Rocky and Potoroo
- Total of 31,000m drilled to date:
 - 29m @ 1.36% Li₂O from 38m (KHRC0011)¹
 - 31m @ 1.13% Li₂O from 86m, incl. 20m @ 1.43% Li₂O (KHRC116)²
 - **27m @ 1.32% Li₂O** from 64m (KHRC017)³
 - **23m @ 1.19% Li₂O** from 44m (KHDD001)¹
- Known footprint of mineralised system extends over
 900m and remains open along strike

Flagship **Big Red deposit has 600m+ strike** from southern outcrop to northern-most intercept, where it remains **thick, shallow and open**


EXTENSION GROWING THE HIGH-GRADE BIG RED SYSTEM



Building immediate resource and development potential

- Next phase of drilling to target further northern extension of Big Red, where it remains open along strike and down dip
- Subsequent stages to include drill-out of recently discovered Potoroo pegmatites
- Excellent metallurgical test results have demonstrated Big Red is readily amenable to conventional Dense Media Separation and Froth Flotation separation techniques
- Hybrid flowsheet design (DMS + float)
 expected to maximise process outcomes






