Built upon the successes and high performance of AEM's existing family of loudspeaker systems, the LHS41 delivers unmatched audio clarity and Sound Pressure Level (SPL) output from an impressively efficient and relatively compact mechanical package.

AEM's loudspeaker systems are already the preferred solution for aerial firefighting operators and law enforcement agencies, including on aircraft being used by CAL FIRE and many other agencies fighting the devastating wildfires in California.
