# **E79 GOLD MINES LTD EXERCISES OPTION**

## **Mountain Home Project**

NT Minerals Limited (ASX: NTM) ("NT Minerals", "NTM" or "the Company") is pleased to announce that E79 Gold Mines Ltd (E79) has today exercised the option over the Mountain Home Project in the Northern Territory. The Option Agreement, executed between the Company's wholly owned subsidiary Redbank Operations Pty Ltd and E79 (ASX: 28 May 2024 – NTM Options EL32470 to E79 Gold Mines Limited) (Agreement) .

### **KEY POINTS**

- E79 assigned the rights under the Agreement to Iguana Minerals Pty Ltd (a wholly owned subsidiary) (Iguana) on 10 April 2025.
- Iguana has delivered an Option Exercise Notice under the Agreement
- In consideration of the early exercise of the Option the Company has agreed to reduce the NSR to 1% and capped at \$1.5m, with Iguana having the first right of refusal to purchase the NSR for \$1.0m.
- A Royalty Deed has been executed by the parties.
