Meeting to replace Yowie board proceeds on 27 June 2025

Keybridge Capital Limited (ASX: KBC) (**Keybridge**) is pleased to announce that the meeting it has called to replace the directors of its subsidiary company, Yowie Group Ltd (**Yowie**) (**Yowie 249F Meeting**), will proceed as called on 27 June 2025 at the offices of Mills Oakley in Melbourne at 10am.

On Friday 20 June 2025, the NSW Supreme Court declared that:

- Yowie's attempts to postpone the Yowie 249F Meeting and change the venue were invalid and of no effect.
- Keybridge's notice of meeting, and the notices of intention to remove the Yowie directors and nominate for election the proposed directors for the Yowie 249F Meeting, are valid.
- Keybridge is entitled to vote its interests as shareholder at each resolution put to the Yowie 249F Meeting.

The Court has also ordered, on Keybridge's application, that Dr R P Austin act as independent chair of the Yowie 249F Meeting.

Keybridge directly holds approximately 58% of Yowie's total issued shares and intends to vote all its Yowie shares **FOR** the resolutions.

All Yowie shareholders are encouraged to submit their proxy forms ahead of the meeting, in accordance with the notice of meeting provided, including via online at <u>https://www.votingonline.com.au/yowie</u>.
