### **Agreement Terms**

The Company has reseller rights to the Kognitive suite of products at prices agreed from time to time as outlined in a further Pricing Agreement. The Company is free to establish the prices at which it resells Kognitive Networks Products and Kognitive Networks Services to Customers individually or bundled with VSN.

The Company is not able to determine the financial impact of this Agreement at this early stage.
