Strategic Appointment of US Critical Metals Geology Expert

Great Northern Minerals Ltd (ASX:GNM) (GNM or the Company) is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr Greg Schifrin, President of MinEx Corp., to lead the Company's critical mineral exploration activities in the United States. This appointment is a pivotal step in GNM progressing exploration of its Catalyst Ridge Project located within the Mountain Pass District, in California's Mojave Desert.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Catalyst Ridge Project is located in the world-renowned Mountain Pass District, a
 globally significant rare earth element mining area in California's Mojave Desert. The
 Project is directly adjacent to MP Materials Corp. (NYSE: MP; US\$13bn market cap),
 Locksley Resources Ltd (ASX:LKY), Bayan Mining and Minerals Ltd (ASX:BMM) and
 within 6km from Dateline Resources Ltd (ASX:DTR) Colosseum project.
- Greg Schifrin is a highly respected geologist and mining executive with over 36 years
 of experience in critical mineral exploration. He has held senior roles in multiple listed
 entities, including Megado Minerals Ltd (ASX:MEG), Magellan Gold Corp (OTC:MAGE)
 and Blackrock Silver Corp (TSXV:BRC), and has successfully led remote area
 exploration programs across a range of commodities including rare earths, gold,
 antinomy and uranium.
- Greg's Mountain Pass experience includes having previously worked on Locksley Resources Ltd's (ASX:LKY) Mojave and El Campo Critical Minerals Project.
- Greg and his team to complete a geophysical review of the Catalyst Ridge Project and to establish a detailed program of works for systematic geochemical sampling which will focus on the targets and structures identified from the review.
- The aim of this work is to vector into areas of outcropping REE or antimony-gold mineralisation with the view to developing drill targets for drill testing.
- GNM North American representatives to attend the upcoming Rare Earth Mines,
 Magnets and Motors conference in Toronto.



Greg Schifrin, commented: "I'm excited to join Great Northern Minerals at such a pivotal time in its growth. The Catalyst Ridge Project presents a compelling opportunity to contribute to the development of a secure and sustainable supply of critical minerals in the United States. I was drawn to the Project due to its proximity to Mountain Pass, the scope for new exploration is the area and my previous experience in the area working with Locksley Resources where I noted many interesting geological formations while walking the ground. I look forward to working with the GNM team to advance exploration and unlock the full potential of this asset."

Greg's extensive experience in mineral exploration and project development aligns perfectly with our ambitions at Catalyst Ridge and beyond.




Figure 1: Interpreted bedrock geology map from the US Geological Survey¹ showing the location of the recently acquired GNM claims in relation to the Mountains Pass REE deposit, associated nearby mineral occurrences and other companies operating in the area.
