A critical step forward for Alexium this year was that we realized a clear market need in the cooling sector, and developed a novel solution to fit that need, Alexicool™. With Alexicool™, we have proven we can leverage that part of our business model into adjacent areas quickly and successfully.

# PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT

### **Alexicool**

This month, the team attended several domestic production trials, helping to secure additional business in the PCM (bedding) market. We also attended several production trials across Europe to facilitate the commercialization of Alexicool.

We have identified several markets that have been seeking phase change solutions that we could provide, with one of these customers already in commercial-scale production. This effort will be a major focus in the beginning of

The team has produced multi-ton batches at two toll manufacturers in the U.S. and has plans to scale to a similar size in Europe over the next quarter.

Over the next month, the team will be attending additional trials in the U.S. as well as three European Countries.

# **Tenting**

We are please to say interest in Alexiflam™ PB, Alexium's light weight nylon/polyester FR technology, is continuing to show successful growth. Previously mentioned trials of Alexiflam™ PB have just recently commenced in China with additional trials scheduled throughout Asia by the end of CY16.

The Product Development team will be attending a commercial-scale trial for the Alexiflam PB FR treatment with a recently selected toll manufacturer. This is a very exciting flame retardant application after a 3rd quarter full of Phase Change Material news.



# RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT

As everyone is aware, Alexium has moved into its new facility in South Carolina. This move is significant in a number of ways.

First and foremost, the new facility upgrades and expands our technical capabilities. We had clearly grown beyond the usable space at our previous site, and this new facility allows us to structure the labs more practically. Key testing and scale-up functions are now integrated as distinct spaces in our laboratories; this all improves the overall quality of the technical teams' output. Also, the new facility was designed with room for growth. With the rapid

evolution of new products such as Alexiflam NF and Alexicool, we can see where our future needs will be. The new laboratories are designed to allow us to grow as a company along with our products.

Another key aspect of this move is what it represents for Alexium. Alexium has grown significantly over the past few years and this new facility is an important step in that. In many ways, the previous building was a poor representation of what we have built and become. We are all very pleased that our facilities now represent us well to customers, investors, and the public as a whole.

## **GROWTH & SALES**

The Sales Department has closed multiple pieces of new business in 4Q16 as we aim for a very strong finish to CY16. As we prepare for a bulk plant trial for 1Q17 adaptation near Shanghai in December, we are working with the top brands in parallel so we can complete a market transition to Alexium

technology in a matter of months. We also have achieved the highest tier burn ratings for Pyroman for Military Applications which has been a core market for Alexium since our inception.
