DRILLING UNDERWAY:

DIAMOND CORE AT NAMBI TO FURTHER TEST GOLD MINERALISED SYSTEM

NTM GOLD LTD is pleased to advise that diamond drilling has re-commenced at the Company's Nambi Deposit within the 100% owned Redcliffe Gold Project.

This stage of drilling is to consist of two diamond drill holes for approximately 500 metres to intersect both the Main Lode and East Lodes, at interpreted down plunge high grade positions.

Recent diamond drilling (see ASX release on Nambi Diamond Drilling 22 August 2016) indicated the potential for the existence of a robust mineralised system as lodes were intersected at depths significantly greater than previously drilled. A **Main Lode** intercept of **6m** @ **6.62g/t gold** was returned and the drilling also showed that the **East Lodes** are becoming increasingly important at depth, as it included an intercept of **3.2m** @ **9.86g/t gold**.

Results will be available over the next few weeks upon logging, cutting and assaying of mineralised intervals. Information will then be incorporated into the database to aid re-estimation of resources to JORC 2012 compliance.
