FOD withdraws from acquisition of Healthy Warrior

Food and beverage processing company The Food Revolution Group (ASX: FOD) ("FOD" or the "Company") wishes to advise that it will not proceed with its proposed acquisition of Healthy Warrior and Future Generation Foods ("Healthy Warrior") and an associated capital raise.

The board believes that proceeding with the acquisition and capital raise at the Company's current share price would be unfair and not in the best interest of existing shareholders as it would undervalue FOD.

FOD will continue its focus on building its business organically and through strategic alliances with distributors, which to date include Australia's major supermarkets and service stations.

Healthy Warrior founder and sole director Matthew Bailey will continue in his role as a Non-Executive Director of FOD.
