S Victory Bore Project - Exploration Update

HIGHLIGHTS:

Field verification of historical gold exploration activities and targets is to commence imminently in order to potentially prepare for a drilling campaign to be completed across the targets delineated.

With the recent surge in demand in high-density battery storage, Quest is also undertaking a review of the vanadium potential within the Victory Bore project area. Vanadium is utilised in both battery storage (vanadium redox batteries) and the more traditional steel alloy industries.
