REQUEST FOR A TRADING HALT

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Botanix Pharmaceuticals Limited (ASX:BOT) (Company) requests a trading halt of its securities from ASX with effect from commencement of trading on Thursday 17 August 2017.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the Company provides the following information regarding this request:

- 1. The reason for the trading halt is that the Company intends to make an announcement regarding ethics approval for its BTX 1503 acne patient study.
- 2. The Company requests that the trading halt continue until the earlier of commencement of trading on Monday 21 August 2017 or when the announcement referred to in paragraph 1 is released to the market.
- 3. The Company expects the event which will end the trading halt is the announcement referred to in paragraph 1.
