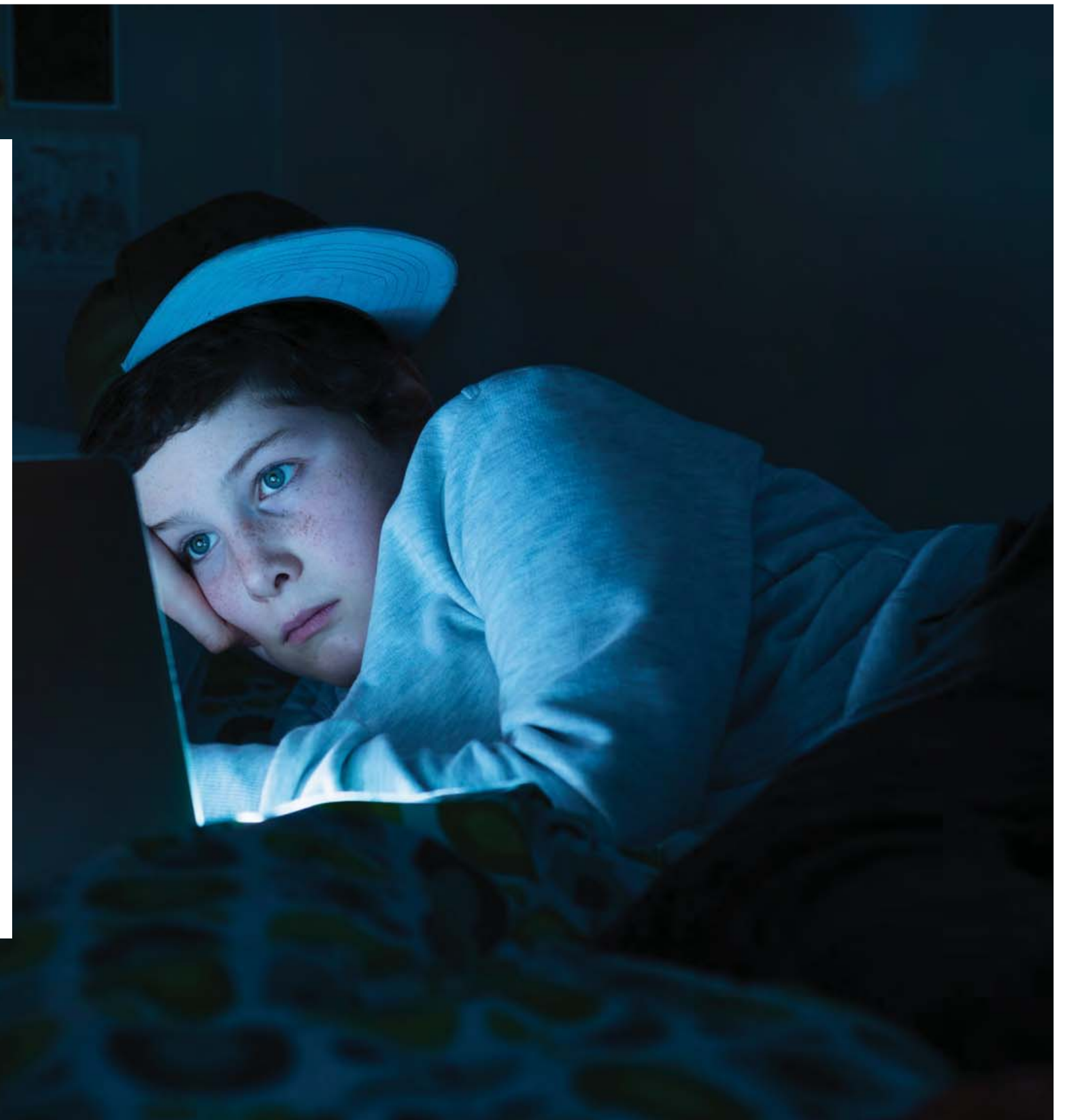

## Parental Control Software - Different Approaches

### Competitors that Block

- Hardware can be hard to setup, manage and maintain
- Management software can be time consuming and complex
- Give parents a false sense of security that all bad things are blocked
- Increases resentment and anger in children
- Sets parents against children, leaving children isolated when real threats emerge

### Competitors that Spy

- Allows parents to record specific email, post and keyboard activity
- Sends a message that children can't be trusted with any privacy at all
- Erodes trust between parents and children





## The Blocking Effect - Researched Facts

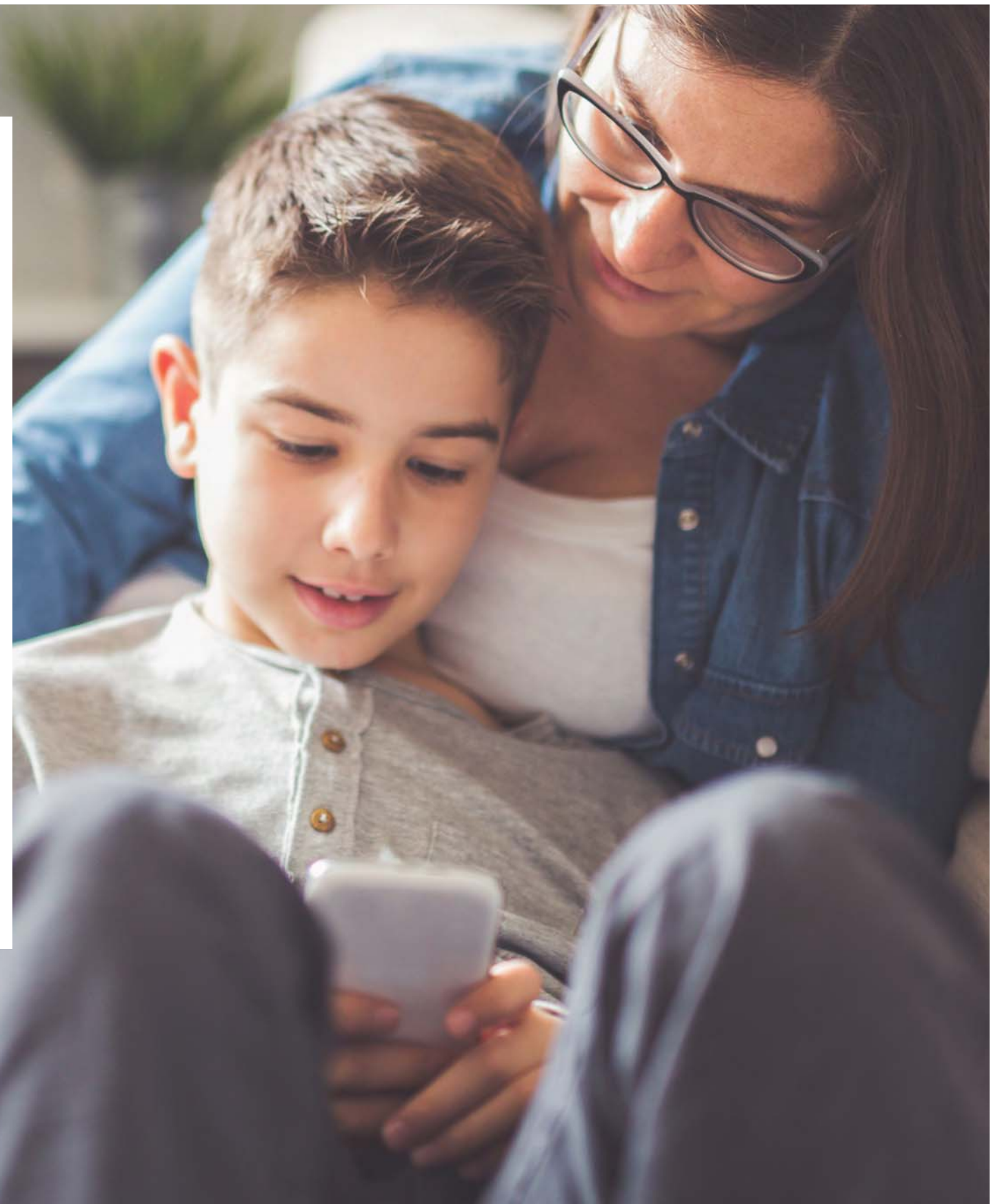
Oxford University Study 2016

**"Internet filtering technology and Adverse Experiences in Adolescents"**, was published today in the **Journal of Pediatrics**, and says the effectiveness of internet filters is **"dubious"**.

Contrary to expectations, we found equivocal to strong evidence that caregivers' use of internet filtering technology did not reduce the chance of adolescents having recent aversive online experiences.

The formidable challenge of preventing all aversive experiences underlines the importance of helping parents, carers, and educators to support children and adolescents in developing the resilience to manage such experiences.

**Researchers from the University of Oxford** have suggested that, instead of rolling out internet filters, those who are concerned about what children encounter online should spend some time helping their parents to parent.

## Professor Donna Cross

### Director

Donna Cross is a Professor with the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences at the University of Western Australia and the Telethon Kids Institute. Donna has an international reputation for developing community-based interventions to reduce bullying and aggression among young people. She is currently a lead investigator on six 2-5 year longitudinal research projects developed to prevent bullying, cyberbullying and associated mental health harms among Australian children and adolescents. Her strong focus on translational strategies has culminated in the dissemination of an evidence-based program called Friendly Schools Plus to over 3,000 Australian schools and schools in the USA and the UK and Scandinavia.



## Robyn Treyvaud

### Head of Education

In 2008 I established Cyber Safe Kids, a consultancy that partnered with Federal and State governments, media, schools (nationally and internationally) and non-profit organisations to deliver programs and resources to educate, empower and engage people about cyber safety. I became the first global partner of Common Sense Media [US] and was on the Global Advisory Board for Norton's Online Family in 2007. As an international keynote speaker I have established a global network of cyber safety experts and have had significant input into the agendas and resources of not for profit organisations and educational communities. As a facilitator of professional learning for the International Baccalaureate Organisation in Asia-Pacific I have influenced the explicit teaching of digital citizenship in schools primary and secondary.





## Telethon Kids Institute

Telethon Kids Institute is a medical research institute based in Perth. It is one of two principal beneficiaries of the Channel 7 Telethon Trust, which boasts the support of some of Australia's largest companies and institutions.

Telethon has raised over \$250 Million in its history including this year's record of over \$36 Million.

The Institute will provide access to resources for parents, educators, caregivers and children to help address the opportunities and risks identified with online behaviour.

Partnership also opens up key communication channels across schools, families and a global network of practitioners and researcher bodies.

Professor Donna Cross is Director of CoLab -- Collaborate for Kids, an early childhood development research initiative with Telethon Kids and the Minderoo Foundation. Professor Cross has been appointed to the Wangle Board.
