This Notice is given by Alloy Resources Limited (ACN 109 361 195) ("Alloy") under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) ("The Act").

Alloy has today issued a total of 150,000,000 ordinary fully paid shares without disclosure under Part 6D.2 of the Corporations Act.

125,000,000 ordinary fully paid shares were issued pursuant to a share purchase plan which closed on 1 November 2017.

The SPP terms were amended to allow acceptance of oversubscription in excess of \$500,000 and a further 25,000,000 ordinary fully paid shares were issued under the Company's 15% capacity under Listing Rule 7.1.
