SECTION 708AA CLEANSING NOTICE - RIGHTS ISSUE

For the purposes of section 708AA(2)(f) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (the "Corporations Act") as modified by ASIC Corporations (Non-Traditional Rights Issues) Instrument 2016/84 (ASIC Instrument), ShareRoot Limited (the "Company") hereby provides notice that on 23 January 2018 the Company announced the successful completion of the Rights Issue Shortfall ("Shortfall"). As the Shortfall was oversubscribed 162,936,288 additional shares were also issued to sophisticated and professional investors (Additional Shares") at an issue price of \$0.005 per share.
