## Activities

During the quarter, Oakajee Corporation Limited ('the Company') continued to assess various opportunities in the resources sector and in particular, early-mid stage exploration.

The Company aims to acquire a suitable project and submit to the ASX for re-quotation of its securities. Further updates will be provided to the market as and when required.

#### Corporate

During the quarter, the Company received a capital return payment of \$495,000 for its shares held in Santa Fe Minerals Limited (formerly EZA Corporation Limited).

At the end of the quarter, the Company held approximately \$1 million in cash, 11,000,000 shares in Santa Fe Minerals Limited and 1,000,000 shares in Aurelia Metals Limited. At 31 December 2017, the market value of the Company's investment in these listed entities was \$1,475,000.
