SECONDARY TRADING NOTICE – NOTIFICATION PURSUANT

This notice is given by Riversgold Limited (ACN 617 614 598) (“Riversgold”) under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (“the Act”).
