Request for voluntary suspension

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Mount Ridley Mines Limited (ASX: MRD) (or "the Company") requests voluntary suspension of its securities from commencement of trading on Monday, 7 May 2018, pending an announcement regarding the acquisition of Prometheus Developments Pte Ltd.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information regarding the request:

- The reason for the request for voluntary suspension is to enable the Company further time to finalise agreements in relation to the Trading Halt requested on Thursday, 3 May 2018.
- The Company expects the voluntary suspension to end no later than the commencement of trading on Tuesday, 8 May 2018 when it anticipates to make the announcement to the acquisition of Prometheus Developments Pte Ltd.
- The Company is not aware of any reason as to why the voluntary suspension should not be granted, nor of any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
