## Brazil Truck Drivers Strike Update

**ASX: AVB ('AVANCO' OR 'THE COMPANY')** provides the following update to Avanco's ASX announcement dated 29 May 2018 relating to the truck drivers strike in Brazil.

The Company is pleased to advise the following:

- fuel and other supplies are flowing into Parauapebas;
- the Parauapebas airport has re-opened;
- the Antas mine is receiving fuel shipments and is functioning on a normal 24 hour roster;
- mining activities have recommenced;
- concentrate containers previously detained at the road blocks are now heading safely to the port, with additional containers being loaded onto vessels remedying the shortfall on previous shipments; and
- all scheduled maintenance on the plant was completed during the days the mine was offline.

Given the short term interruption to operations, the Company does not expect a material impact on C1 or AISCC costs for Q2-2018.
