NOTES

1. Basis of Preparation

The audited figures for the period ended 31 December 2017 cover a period during which the current Board of Directors was not in control of the company's management and affairs. The Directors and the Auditor qualify these financials on the basis that, to prepare the financial report, the Directors and Auditor had to reconstruct the Company's financial records using limited data that would be extracted from the Company's accounting system and the record of receipts and payments made available by the Administrators and Deed Administrators. As disclosed elsewhere in the Prospectus dated 11 April 2018 ("the Prospectus") and as previously announced to the market, the Company was subject to a Deed of Company Arrangement ("DOCA"), with the effect of extinguishing the Company's debts and facilitating the recapitalisation of the Company. The DOCA has now been effectuated.

The audit reviewed figures for the period ended 31 December 2017 include the financial information of Antares Energy Limited and its subsidiaries. The financial statements for the period ended 31 December 2017 and the above pro-forma are prepared in Australian Dollars ("AUD").
