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Contract Awards Update

MACA Limited ('MACA') (ASX:MLD) is pleased to provide an update on recent project awards exceeding \$60 million within the MACA Civil, Infrastructure and SMP business units.

These recent contract wins and variations increase MACA's FY19 Work In Hand position for these business units to \$143 million and overall WIH to \$1,051 million

Civil

The following new contract wins and contract variations have recently been awarded to MACA, through its Western Australian based Civil business:

- a Design and Construct Contract with the Main Roads Authority in Western Australia for the Coongan Gorge realignment and other various works. The value of this contract is circa \$30 million, with the bulk of the work expected to be completed by the end of the calendar year;
- a \$12 million variation to the bulk earthworks contract with the Gruyere Joint Venture, which extends contracted works to October 2018; and
- a Civil Earthworks Contract constructing evaporating ponds for Western Areas Limited at its Cosmos Nickel Project, which is expected to generate revenues of around \$5 - 6 million in FY19.

Infrastructure

MACA, through its Victorian based Infrastructure business, has been awarded a \$6 million contract for an intersection upgrade for VicRoads with the bulk of the revenue expected to occur in the second half of the 2018 calendar year.

MACA Interquip

MACA, through subsidiary MACA Interquip, has been awarded a \$6 million structural, mechanical and piping contract by Anglo Gold Ashanti at the Tropicana Gold Project in WA. The works relate to a secondary mill upgrade at the plant and will employ circa 25 employees at peak manning. The works are expected to be completed in the second half of the 2018 calendar year.
