CLEANSING NOTICE UNDER SECTION 708A THE CORPORATIONS ACT 2001 (CTH)

Yojee Limited (**Yojee or the Company**) (**ASX: YOJ**) advises that it has issued 80,000,000 placement shares at an issue price of \$0.10 per share to raise \$8,000,000 (before costs) and 26,666,644 one for three free attaching unquoted options exercisable at \$0.15 on or before 23 January 2020 to institutional and sophisticated investors.
