

QUARTERLY ACTIVITIES REPORT

For the Quarter to 30 June 2018

- During the quarter BMG continued its focus on securing a new investment opportunity for the Company
- The Company has made good progress during the quarter reviewing a number of potential opportunities, and is currently evaluating several of those more closely.
- The Company anticipates it will be in a position to provide a more detailed update on progress shortly
- The Treasure Project in Cyprus continues under management of New Cyprus, the major shareholder, with BMG retaining a free carried interest

During the quarter BMG Resources Limited (the **Company**; ASX: **BMG**) remained actively focussed on securing a new investment opportunity for the Company. As previously stated, the Company has been seeking out mineral project investment opportunities with the potential to deliver strong value growth for shareholders. The Company is particularly interested in 'battery' minerals, but remains open to other mineral projects (and potentially non-mineral opportunities) which have the right investment attributes.

The Company evaluated a number of potential investment opportunities during the quarter, and is currently looking at several of these more closely. The Company is optimistic with the progress it has made, and hopes to be in a position to provide a more detailed update shortly.

The Company continues to retain its 30% free-carried interest in the Treasure Project in Cyprus. The Treasure Project's operator, New Cyprus Copper Company Limited, is the majority shareholder and is responsible for maintaining and progressing the project.

Directors and management continued to substantially hold all fees during the quarter while the Company is focussed on securing a new investment opportunity.

The Treasure Project, of which BMG currently owns a 30% interest, comprises 10 exploration licences for a total of 36.654 km².
