- Joint marketing initiatives to promote Vonex as the preferred supplier for existing and new Bria customers in Australia

Its Stretto PlatformTM enables the provisioning of desktop and mobile VoIP software. CounterPath Bria software is used by millions of users across the globe.

The partnership agreement will see both parties collaboratively working on new customer growth in Australia. For Vonex, this could open up much larger opportunities to work with enterprise clients previously not targeted, plus enable Vonex to expand its offering to existing business, enterprise and channel customers.

Vonex will also white-label selected CounterPath products and sell under its own brand. To this end Vonex has made an initial order of 10,000 licenses of the CounterPath Bria softphone client suite and the CounterPath Stretto Platform which it intends to sell to its existing customer base.

Under the terms of the non-exclusive agreement Vonex and CounterPath, who has a base of established customers, will jointly market a combined product offering to existing and potential customers of both companies, initially in the Australian market.

• The CounterPath Bria soft phone client suite, which enables consumers and business users to make VoIP (Voice over IP) audio and video calls, send instant messages, share their screens, and manage their presence in an easy-to-use, seamless software application across several operating systems.

• The CounterPath Stretto Platform is a carrier-grade provisioning, messaging, collaboration, analytics and mobility experience management platform that enables enterprises and service providers to build flexible solutions which meet their specific communication and deployment requirements.

Commenting on the agreement, Vonex Managing Director Matt Fahey said, "this agreement is a significant win-win for both parties. Vonex and CounterPath complement each other's business in so many ways and through joint marketing to existing and targeted customers. I believe we can offer a very compelling product offering in addition to our existing product offerings."

"Existing CounterPath customers, who currently only access software solutions, can now be offered connection to the Vonex VoIP solutions, while Vonex customers can now have access to a world class voice, video and messaging software solution. We will be able to offer an enhanced experience to customers of both companies, in an extremely cost-effective way."

Joint Engineering Activities

In addition to the joint marketing activities, the development and engineering divisions of both groups will engage in a range of collaborative engineering activities.

While these activities will primarily be designed to assist CounterPath with further tailoring its products to the Australian market requirements, Vonex believes its collaboration with the CounterPath engineering division will also assist with fast-tracking the development/enhancement of its own product range and give it unique insights into a range of global technology developments.

"We will have access to one of the most experienced technical teams in the telephony / video space, which will give us immense benefit as we tailor products and solutions for our joint marketing efforts and develop our own product range," Mr. Fahey added.

The Agreement is for an initial period of one year and can able to be extended by either party to the agreement for successive additional one-year periods.
