Smelter Update

Gulf Manganese Corporation Limited (ASX: GMC) (“Gulf” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce that the Company’s first 140 tonne shipment of structural steel has arrived from Weltes in Surabaya and is being offloaded at the Tenau Port in Kupang. In addition to the steel, Gulf also took delivery of Prefabricated Site Offices and Workshops.

Fabricated steel from the Weltes engineering facilities in Surabaya is being progressively shipped to Kupang, subject to vessel availability. Weltes have already mobilised a construction team and once their site infrastructure (including site office, workshop and tool store) for this team are established, will commence erection.
