## CSD APPOINTS FORMER NSW PREMIER MORRIS IEMMA CHAIRMAN

Mining company Consolidated Tin Mines Limited (**ASX: CSD**) is pleased to announce the appointment of former NSW Premier, the Hon. Morris Iemma, as its new Non-Executive Chairman, as part of a restructure of the Board.

Mr Iemma replaces Ralph De Lacey and Kwok Ching Tsoi, who served as joint Executive Co-Chairs of the company. Mr Tsoi has stepped-down from the Board, whilst Mr De Lacey who served as Chairman/Managing Director continues as Managing Director of the company. Yading (Caden) Wan has also been appointed as a new Non-Executive Director.

As the company's new Chairman, Mr Iemma has a distinguished 17-year NSW political career, holding several key portfolios including Treasurer; Minister for Public Works; Minister for Health; Minister for Sport and Recreation; and Minister for Citizenship. Mr Iemma notably served as the NSW Premier from 2005-2008.

Mr Iemma is currently Chairman of Greyhound Racing NSW; District Commissioner for the Greater Sydney Commission and sits on the Board of TAFE NSW and is Chairman of Riverwood Community Centre, Miracle Babies Foundation and NSW Cancer Institute. He has previously served on the Boards of Beyond Blue, the SCG Trust and as Chair of the South East Sydney Health District.

"I am excited to be Chairing and contributing to the future direction of CSD as the company advances to the next phase of its corporate strategy, expanding exploration and developing its pipeline of base metals – for local and overseas markets," Mr Iemma said.

"CSD is now well-positioned to pursue new opportunities, adding to its existing production of zinc, copper, lead and gold."

Mr Iemma said CSD will be identifying and appointing additional Directors with a "breadth of skills and corporate experience" in order to strengthen the Board.
