# COMPLETION OF SHARE PLACEMENT TO RAISE \$6,000,000

Technology Metals Australia Limited (ASX: TMT) ("Technology Metals" or the "Company") is pleased to announce subsequent to the announcement on 28 September 2018, the Company has now issued a total of 12,000,000 fully paid ordinary shares ("Placement") at a price of \$0.50 per share to raise \$6,000,000 before costs.

The Placement Shares were issued under the Company's capacity pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 7.1 (6,747,750 Shares) and 7.1A (5,252,250 Shares). Monies raised will be used to advance the Definitive Feasibility Study ("**DFS**") on the Company's wholly owned Gabanintha Vanadium Project, fund additional exploration activities and for working capital purposes.
