Gladiator Resources Ltd (Company) is pleased to advise that it has formally engaged United Drilling Services Pty Ltd (UDS) as its preferred driller for the Company's upcoming drilling program at the North Arunta Project, a joint venture between the Company and Prodigy Gold (ASX: PRX). UDS is an experienced drilling company having been in operation since 1994.

UDS has begun mobilisation and is expected to arrive on site Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> November with the drill rig scheduled to commence drilling on 13<sup>th</sup> November. An agreement has been reached with the land holder for access to drilling water and notice of entry has been served by the Company.

The maiden drilling campaign will include approximately 2,000 metres of RC drilling and 250 metres of diamond drilling and is expected to take approximately 1 month to complete. Samples will be sent for analysis in Perth during the program with results to be released progressively once available.

The Company's contracted geologist and field assistant will be on site this week to oversee final track and drill pad clearing works including camp set up ahead of the drill rigs arrival.

The program aims to test the prominent IP chargeability anomalies identified during the survey conducted in June and July of this year (ASX 29<sup>th</sup> June 2018; 17<sup>th</sup> July 2018). Secondary aims are to verify grades reported from historic drilling and to obtain crucial geological (particularly structural) information that will enable cost-effective definition of resources.

The Company will provide further updates during the duration of the drilling program.
