VECTOR RESOURCES LIMITED (ASX: VEC) – REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Vector Resources Limited (Company) requests a temporary suspension from quotation be granted by the ASX, with respect to the Company's quoted securities.

The request for suspension follows on from the trading halt requested on Wednesday, 30 January 2019 pending an announcement by the Company in relation to the financial completion of the Adidi-Kanga Gold Project acquisition in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company provides the following information regarding this request:

1. The voluntary suspension is being requested pending an announcement by the Company in relation to the financial completion of the Adidi-Kanga Gold Project acquisition in Democratic Republic of Congo;
2. The Company anticipates the suspension to remain in place until the commencement of trading on Thursday, 7 February 2019 or when the announcements referred to in paragraph 1 are released to the market;
3. The event which will end the voluntary suspension are the announcements referred to in paragraph 1; and
4. It is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted or any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
