All Mining Tenure Granted

Kalium Lakes Limited (KLL) is pleased to advise that all of the required Mining Tenure for its 100% owned Beyondie Sulphate Of Potash Project (BSOPP) has now been granted by the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DMIRS). The Tenure includes two Mining Leases (M), 15 Miscellaneous Licences (L) and a gas pipeline licence (PL), in addition to the 15 granted exploration Licences (E).

The tenure covers all required project activities, including:

- Mining (Brine Extraction)
- Evaporation Ponds
- SOP Purification
- All Roads including Product Haul Road Connecting to the Great Northern Highway
- Water Supply Borefield and Pipelines
- Communications
- Gas Pipeline
- Power Generation
- Accommodation Facilities
- Supporting Infrastructure

Importantly, all Mining Tenure has been granted with the consent of the Determined Native Title holders, the Gingirana People and the Birriliburu People, in accordance with the signed Mining Land Access Agreements. Also, all of the Exploration Licences have been granted in accordance with the Land Access and Mineral Exploration Agreements.




Figure 1: Beyondie Sulphate Of Potash Project - Mining Tenure




Figure 2: Stage 1 – Represents approximately 21% of the total lake surface area within the tenement packages www.kaliumlakes.com.au Page 3 of 5

Kalium Lakes' full list of exploration and mining tenure is set out in Table 1, with Figures 1 and 2 (below) providing the tenure location detail for the Stage 1 area of the project.

Managing Director, Brett Hazelden, commented: "The grant of all of our Mining Tenure requirements allows the full value chain to be accomplished including, extraction of the brine, evaporation to form salts, SOP purification and haulage to the Australian agricultural industry or an export port.

"Kalium Lakes is the only company to have all the tenure requirements granted to develop what we expect will be the first commercial SOP production facility in Australia.

"We would like to thank the Gingirana People and the Birriliburu People traditional owners for their consent and ongoing support of the Project," he said.

Corporate Profile



Kalium Lakes Limited is an exploration and development company, focused on developing the Beyondie Sulphate Of Potash Project in Western Australia with the aim of producing Sulphate of Potash (SOP), a high yield, premium fertiliser, for both domestic and international markets. There is currently no SOP production in Australia.

Approaching a Final Investment Decision, the Company has just completed a Bankable Feasibility Study for the Project (the first BFS for any Australian deposit) which confirmed the Project is technically and financially robust, with first production anticipated in 2020.

The Project aims to commence production at 82ktpa of SOP, before ramping up to 164ktpa of SOP for domestic and international sale. An initial mine life of between 30-50 years is anticipated for a project designed to be a low cost, long life and high margin producer.



The Carnegie Joint Venture (CJV) is focussed on the exploration and development of the Carnegie Potash Project (CPP) in Western Australia, which is located approximately 220 kilometres east-north-east of Wiluna and covers a total area of approximately 3,081 square kilometres.

The CJV is a Joint Venture between Kalium Lakes (KLL, 70% Interest) and BCI Minerals (BCI, 30% interest). The JV Companies have endorsed proceeding to a staged Pre-Feasibility Study, with an initial focus on securing tenure and access to all required tenements.
