



 - Plus areas around existing prospects including Hub, Infinity & Aliso









Leonora - An Emerging Area that is over 120 years old

- Gold mined continuously since the 1890's in the region.
- Existing Mines:
 - Gwalia St Barbara (ASX: SBM);
 - > Thunderbox Saracen (ASX: SAR);
 - > Mt Morgans Dacian (ASX: DCN);
 - Darlot Red 5 (ASX: RED).

 - > KIN (ASX: KIN).






MSZ – Highly Fertile System

- ~40km of strike of the Mertondale Shear Zone (MSZ).
- A major regional linking structure with multiple deposits.
- Mineralisation often associated with kinks or bends in the shear zone or cross cutting structures.

Missed the higher grade plunging shoots at depth.




Regional Long Sections




High-Grade Plunging Shoots – Deeper Drilling Required




Southern Prospects/Deposits

1H - Resource Focussed

- Resource build drilling:
 - > 17,097m RC,
 - > 851m diamond.
- Extended Nambi, GTS at depth.
- Drilled out Bindy for maiden resource.
- Increased resource 94% to 538koz¹

2H - Exploration Focussed

- Tested 12 new targets:
 - > 17,998m aircore.
- Outstanding results with 50% success rate:
 - > +1g/t intercepts in 6 prospects.







Nambi

- Mineralisation from surface.
- Three separate sub-parallel lodes 2 -5m true thickness.
- Highest-grade Redcliffe Project deposit:
 - > 1.7Mt @ 2.73g/t for 138koz 1
- But
 - Resource estimate limited by drilling.
 - Mineralisation plunges to the south.
 - > Open at depth.
- Intercepts include:
 - > 0.5m @ 166.0 g/t
 - > 0.5m @ 66.8 g/t
 - > 4m @ 7.2 g/t inc/ 1m@20.2 g/t
 - > 5m @ 7.0 g/t inc/ 1m@17.1 g/t




Redcliffe Deposits



Golden Terrace South (GTS)

- Large system with oxide.
- +1km strike and +150m vertical.
- Open at strike and depth.
- Oxide comes to surface.
- Largest Redcliffe Project deposit:
 - > 2.8Mt @ 1.52g/t for 138koz 1
- But
 - Resource estimate limited by drilling.
 - > Mineralisation plunges to the south.
 - > Open at depth.
- Intercepts include:
 - > 11m @ 4.5 g/t inc/ 1m@10.7g/t
 - > 14m @ 3.5 g/t incl 4m @6.4 g/t
 - > 12m @ 2.7g/t inc/ 3m @5.9 g/t
 - > 6m @ 3.20 g/t



Successful Exploration


- Exploration required for a step change in the resource base.
- Over 30 targets identified from systematic in-house process.
- Recent very successful aircore program:
 - Intercepted +1g/t in 6 of the 12 targets.
- Areas included:
 - > Hub,
 - > Aliso,
 - > Infinity,
 - > Redcliffe East, and
 - Bindy North
- Multiple other targets to follow up.





Outstanding Start


- Initial mineralisation identified from aircore with +300m of strike with +1 g/t hits on 4 consecutive lines.
- Mineralisation on Mafic-Felsic contact.
- No drilling north of the dyke for 800m, where there is a +1g/t intercept in historic drilling.
- Structurally complex with a cross cutting dyke.
- Completed 4 RC holes before Christmas which intercepted mineralisation at ~250m downhole.





Drilling Underway


- Pre Christmas drill results include:
 - > 12m @ 4.6 g/t incl 4m@9.3g/t
 - > 7m @ 3.7 g/t inc/ 2m@6.9g/t
 - > 3m @ 5.2 g/t incl 1m@10.5g/t
- Additional 5 RC holes since completedresults pending.
- 1 diamond hole due to start within a few weeks.
- Needs more drilling to understand strike and influence of the dyke but an excellent outcome for a greenfields target.





Brand New Area

- Northern-most prospect, located 7km north of Nambi.
- Never been drilled.
- High-quality first pass results:
 - > 5m @ 3.6g/t
 - > 5m @ 1.2g/t
 - > 5m @ 1.1g/t
- 3 drill traverses 100m apart with mineralisation on each.
- Possible porphyry host.
- Highly sheared.
- Follow-up aircore planned for March.




Many Other Follow-Up Targets



Multiple +1g/t hits

First pass aircore highlighted many other areas worthwhile following up, including:

- Infinity large gaps between drilling:
 - > 5m @ 1.4g/t
 - > 5m @ 1.3g/t
- Bindy North extends Bindy trend to +2km:
 - > 5m @ 1.6g/t
- Redcliffe East:
 - > 2m @ 3.5g/t
 - > 5m @ 4.7g/t
- Redcliffe South:
 - > 5m @ 1.2g/t
 - > 5m @ 1.1g/t




Looking Forward



2019 Drilling Already Started – Busy Period Ahead

- RC program just completed testing Hub, Redcliffe East, Infinity, GTS, Nambi and Bindy:
 - > Extensional holes on existing deposits,
 - > Testing depth continuity at new prospects.
- Diamond drilling to commence shortly:
 - Large step outs on existing deposits,
 - > Can be used in future resource updates.
- Aircore drilling planned from mid-March:
 - > Testing more new prospects to generate additional RC targets,
 - > Following up other areas.

Indicative Exploration Timetable



Other Activities

- Engage external consultants for structural and targeting review:
 - > First external project review in several years.
- Strategic alignment with DGO Gold Limited formed late 2019:
 - Already contributed \$0.5m,
 - > Up to another \$1.5m before the end of March 2019 at 4cps,
 - Up to \$11m in total funding over 3 years,
 - > Leverage off DGO technical expertise.



- > Needs to be a natural fit and enhance our standing in the region,
- > Remain focussed on gold,
- We see Leonora as an outstanding region in which to be exploring.
