

Secondary Trading Notice - 708A(5)

Winchester Energy Limited (**Winchester** or **Company**) has issued 59,301,609 Shortfall Shares of the 100,175,370 Shortfall Shares per the announcement dated 7 February 2019. The Shares were issued to sophisticated and professional shareholders at \$0.02 cents each to raise \$\$1,186,032.18 before costs. Subject to funds of \$552,475 clearing a further 27,623,761 Shortfall Shares will be issued.

Application for 13,250,000 of the Shortfall Shares has been made by Directors of the Company. These shares will only be issued subject to shareholder approval. It is anticipated that a notice of meeting will be mailed to shareholders shortly.

An Appendix 3B is attached to this notice.

Secondary Trading Exemption

The Corporations Act 2001 ("**Act**") restricts the on-sale of securities issued without disclosure, unless the sale is exempt under section 708 or 708A. By the Company giving this notice, sale of the Securities noted above will fall within the exemption in section 708A(5) of the Act.

The Company hereby notifies ASX under section 708A(5)(e) of the Act that:
