R&D Prepayment Loan Facility

Advanced Braking Technology Limited (ASX: ABV) ('ABT' or 'the Company') advises that its wholly owned subsidiary Advanced Braking Pty Ltd ('ABPL'), has entered into a short term loan facility for up to \$620,000 with R&D Capital Partners Pty Ltd, as a prepayment of the forecast research and development ('R&D') tax incentive claim for the year ended 30 June 2019 ('R&D Tax Incentive').

ABPL has received an initial draw down of \$420,000, with a second draw down of \$200,000 at ABPL's election and subject to ongoing due diligence by R&D Capital Partners Pty Ltd.

Repayment of the funds advanced is timed to coincide with the receipt of the ABPL's 2019 R&D Tax Incentive refund expected by 30 November 2019.

The Loan Facility funds will be utilised to continue R&D programs and for working capital.

Key terms of the Loan Facility are:

Establishment Fee: \$18,600 (GST Free) payable on first Drawdown;

Interest Rate: 1.25% per month on amounts drawn;

Repayment: No principal loan repayments are to be made until the Repayment Date,

being the earlier of:

- ABPL receiving its 2019 R&D claim under the R&D Tax Incentive from

the ATO

Or

- 30 November 2019

Primary Security Interest: The Primary Security Interest granted by the Borrower to the Lender
