Request for voluntary suspension

In accordance with listing rule 17.2, Macmahon Holdings Limited (ASX: MAH) (Macmahon) requests a voluntary suspension of its securities from quotation from the commencement of trade on Friday, 7 June 2019, and advises that:

- a) The reason for the voluntary suspension is as follows:
 - a. Macmahon requested a trading halt on Wednesday, 5 June 2019 pending the release of an announcement about a material contract negotiation; and
 - b. that negotiation remains ongoing and Macmahon is not yet in a position to make an announcement;
- b) Macmahon requests that the voluntary suspension remain in place until an announcement regarding the above matter is made, and currently expects to make an announcement before the commencement of trading on Tuesday, 11 June 2019; and
- c) Macmahon is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted, nor any other information necessary to inform the market about the voluntary suspension.
