**REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION**

Titan Minerals Limited ("Titan" or "the Company") refers to the trading halt granted to the Company on 26 June 2019.

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, the Company requests that trading in the Company's securities be suspended from the commencement of trading on 28 June 2019.

The Company makes this request pending the release of an announcement ("Announcement") in respect to the decision of the Supreme Court of British Columbia concerning the acquisition of all the issued and outstanding common shares in Core Gold Inc. (TSX-V: CGLD, OTCQX:CGLDF) by Titan, pursuant to a statutory plan of arrangement under the *Business Corporations Act* (British Columbia). It is expected that the suspension will last until Friday, 12 July 2019 or the Company releasing the Announcement, whichever occurs earlier.

The Company is not aware of any reasons why the voluntary suspension should not be granted.
